

SERMON STUDY QUESTIONS FOR FEBRUARY 9, 2014

Sermon Series: The Cross-Shaped Life: A Study In 1 Corinthians

Sermon: "This Is Our Story "

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 10:1-14

- 1. You may have identified some of the different "idols" of our culture from last week's discussion (e.g. sex/romance, power, status, wealth, reputation, security, pleasure, etc.). Which have more influence or pull on you?
- 2. Look at the failures Paul lists in verses 6b-10. Do you see any connection between this list and the kinds of things you mentioned in question 1? What are they? How are they "common to man" (v. 13)?
- 3. Why does Paul list all the blessings the Israelites experienced in verses 1-4? What does that have to do with their failures in the following verses? What is he trying to tell us (vv. 6, 11-12)?
- 4. Why is God so opposed to idolatry? Or to put it another way, why is idolatry so opposed to God? (Reflect: is it possible to have more than one Rock?)
- 5. What did the rock do for the Israelites in the wilderness (there are many instances, but see especially Exodus 17:1-7)? How is Christ our ultimate Rock?
