- 1. What attributes of Christ are described in vs. 7? How are they comforting to the individual believer or the local congregation as they face adversity?
- 2. What is the meaning of the phrase "open door" in vs. 8? See other references in 1 Corinthians 16:9 and Colossians 4:3-4.
- 3. What "open doors" has the Lord given to you?
- 4. What "open doors" is the Lord giving to Central Presbyterian Church?
- 5. What is the cause and consequence of having "little power" (vs. 8)?
- 6. What is the "power source" of the Christian life (see Romans 1:16 and Ephesians 3:14-19)?
- 7. What does "the synagogue of Satan" mean in vs. 9?
- 8. What is the strength that the Lord identifies in this church in vs. 10 and his promise to them?
- 9. What is the significance of the promise that they will be "pillars" in the "temple of my God" (vs. 12)?
- 10. What does it mean for you to be "a pilgrim now and a pillar later"? What are the characteristics of a "pilgrim"? (see 1 Peter 2:11-12)
- 11. How does the gospel free us from slavery to our past, enable to us to journey with the Lord in the present, and long for his coming in the future?
